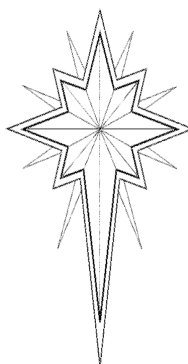

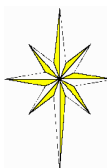
OTHER MINISTRIES AND EVENTS
